Legislative Branch

- 1. Township Supervisors
- 2. County Commissions
- 3. General Assembly House of Representatives and Executive Council (Senate)
- 4. Congress House of Representatives and the Senate (as defined before 1861 A.D.)

Executive Branch

- 1. Constable Governor of the township Chief executive officer of the township
- 2. Sheriff Governor of the county Chief executive officer of the county
- 3. Governor Chief executive officer of the State
- 4. President of the <u>united</u> States of America Chief executive officer of the federal government (*not the color-of-law NATIONAL GOVERNMENT of today*)

Judicial Branch

- 1. Justice of the Peace (not the color-of-law "District Justice" of today)
- 2. Court of Common Pleas Judges
- 3. Pennsylvania Superior Court or Commonwealth Court Judges
- 4. Pennsylvania Supreme Court Justices
- 5. Supreme Court of the <u>united</u> States of America Justices and Judges of lawful inferior courts (*Article III courts only*)
