

What can one person do?

Have you ever heard someone say – “What can I do – I’m just one person”. Well, here is a list of “what I can do”. After completing everything on the list that you are comfortable with and knowledgeable of, it is your responsibility to add to the list and pass it on.

Pray – pray to understand how God’s Providential Hand Blessed our forefathers – pray to know how to be salt and light – pray for guidance in the task at hand.

Kindergarten - Dress up day for founding fathers day - ask to present opposite side of SD to High school & College students

Doctrine of Laches – record and publicly serve elected officials with a statement citing how they have violated your un-a-liable rights by adopting policies - comprehensive plan, smart growth and ordinances to enforce the policies.

Post private land – send notice of posting to all elected officials (principle) that may have cause to order or send an officer (agent) onto your property, also record property posting. Notice to principle is notice to agent.

Enact a state law against Sustainable Development/Agenda 21

Read and understand the locally adopted “Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance” and its connection (through FEMA) to Sustainable Development/Agenda 21. With several people backing you up, present the information to local elected officials.

Determine if ICLEI (International Council on Local Environmental Initiatives) has contracted with your local government. ICLEI is, on page 55 of Agenda 21 given the responsibility of monitoring and aiding in the implementation of Sustainable Development. In Alabama Birmingham and Huntsville have partnered/contracted.

Pick out one thing that is your special interest and learn all about it and SD – professional groups – real estate, engineers, farmers, ranchers, etc.

Go to: <http://geocommons.com/maps/61743> and print out two maps of the Southeastern Ecological Framework (SEF) – one with the SEF and one without. In order to coherently present the information research and understand SEFs’ connection to (*short list*) – Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance, comprehensive planning, transferable development rights, purchase of development rights, ICC – International Building Codes and associated codes, green space - open space programs, rails to trails, green ways, smart growth, new urbanism, etc. Next go to www.keepourrights.org - scroll down on the left hand side to “glossary” – study their terminology. When you understand the definitions of words and phrases utilized by planners and managers you will have an advantage. Use government documents to support and verify your position – two government created power point presentation are: “A Green Infrastructure Approach” – environment.fhwa.dot.gov/integ/ipwg_us301.ppt – and – “Southeastern Ecological Framework Planning for the Future” go to: <http://tinyurl.com/7yk29j6> and click on: “July 7, 2007”.

Never pose important questions to elected officials orally. Require that the written answer has a signature of the responsible elected official. Ask the same (written) question of the appointed (hired gun) first – he will pass the buck to the elected official – who is responsible.

Understand facilitated meetings (<http://comm-org.wisc.edu/syllabi/gambled.htm>), the Delphi technique <http://tinyurl.com/6carycd> and the Hegelian dialectic.

Hegelian dialectic – words or phrases used in such a way as to alter basic principles.
Some examples:

Pro-choice is pro-murder - pro-life is anti-murder – Question – You were at some point in your development an embryo, an infant, a toddler, a child, a teenager, a young adult, - at what point would you agree to be aborted?

What does abortion (murder) have to do with private property rights? Life is the first aspect of property – without life there can be no additional property.

Subdivision – use to mean subdivide acreage into lots for house construction – now, plan for subdivision have to be submitted to a zoning board or non-elected official before division can be recorded. Number of division is set by unelected officials. The purpose for which it is divided is irrelevant. This circumvents the un-a-liable right of inheritance

“Land holding capacity” – this or a similar phrase will be in your comprehensive plan. It was originally known as “carrying capacity” – Number of human beings that will be allowed to occupy a specific area of land.

Animal or pet adoption - Adoption is a process whereby a person assumes the parenting for another and, in so doing, permanently transfers all rights and responsibilities from the original parent or parents. Extending this concept – animals are entitled to all of the rights of man. Example: The mother of the baby whale is missing.

Your rights do not come from the Constitution – hence, you have no Constitutional rights – you have God granted un-a-liable rights – see the Declaration of Independence.

“Inalienable rights” are rights which the processor may give away. As such, from the first communist revolution in France throughout the United Nations documents the latter are recognized.

A phrase to use is: I have God given un-a-liable rights some of which are affirmed in the Constitution.
